Over the past two months, the TTAO has been approached to manage an additional scholarship. The A.T. Tolley Afro-Caribbean Female Scholarship Award is sponsored by a Trinbagonian who came to Canada many years ago, received assistance while pursuing her studies, and has now decided to pay it forward with a \$5,000.00 scholarship. The TTAO is thrilled about this new partnership.

It should be noted that the above scholarship is in addition to the undermentioned three (3) that are currently under the governance of the TTAO:

- C.L.R. James Scholarship, named after the world famous Trinbagonian national, cultural historian, cricket writer and political activist, who was a leading figure in the Pan African movement. Value - \$1,000.00.
- Friends of SERVIAM Scholarship, named after a group which describes itself as a collection of friends with ties to the Caribbean and Ursuline Sisters, who do charitable work both in Canada and in the Caribbean. *Value \$1,000.00*.
- Dr. Sade Francois Scholarship (for young Black Women), named after a past appreciative TTAO scholarship recipient, who has decided to pay it forward. Value -\$1,000.00.
